SB 60 A

Allows acupuncturists and podiatric physicians to claim liability limitation for provision of health care services without compensation.

SB 67

Defines "ambulatory surgical center" for purposes of duties of circulating nurses.

SB 127 A

Changes term "nurse midwife nurse practitioner" to "nurse practitioner specializing in nurse midwifery."

SB 177 Å

Permits licensed hospice program to provide palliative care without obtaining in-home care agency license.

SB 178 A

Permits health care representative to make election for hospice treatment on behalf of incapacitated principal with terminal condition who does not have valid advance directive.

SB 29 A

Modifies terms "venereal disease" and "sexually transmitted disease" to "sexually transmitted infection." Clarifies hearings procedure for certificates of need for certain health care facilities.

SB 61

Increases membership of Oregon Medical Board by one public member.
