HB 2969 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Creates trauma practice integration program in Governor's office to provide assistance to state agencies and private entities in providing trauma-informed services to children and adolescents.

HB 3383 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to develop pilot program contracting with Yamhill County for provision of community-based child welfare services.

HB 3170 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program and Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

HB 3028 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Increases percentage of federal earned income credit allowable as credit against Oregon personal income tax.

HB 3183
Adjusts punctuation in statute.

Possible Work Session

HB 2348 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Early Learning Division to develop pilot program in rural area of state that reimburses child care providers for cost of providing high-quality child care rather than percentage of market rate.

HB 2570 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Oregon Department of Administrative Services to increase size and diversity of group of court appointed special advocates.
