Public Hearing

- SB 543
Authorizes formation of children's service districts.
- SB 804 A
Directs Department of Human Services, after receiving report of alleged child abuse, to notify law enforcement agency where alleged abuse occurred, if county is known.
- SB 167
Aligns definitions in mental health services bill of rights with definitions applicable to reporting of abuse of persons with mental illness.
- SB 176 A
Requires certain filling stations, service stations, garages and other dispensaries that dispense Class 1 flammable liquids to provide equal access to persons with disabilities.
- SB 813 A
Directs Office of Child Care to make reasonable attempt to identify any child care facility, or person or place providing child care, about which it receives complaint if certain information is provided.
- HB 2878 **
Allows board of county commissioners to vote to direct Department of Human Services not to apply for waiver of time limit on receipt of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits for specified adults residing in county. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3189
Requires Department of Human Services to assess and quantify workload impacts of specified policy changes.
