CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02-05-2019 MEETING: Authorizes State Court Administrator to establish Central Violations Bureau and designate employees to act as violations clerks.

Public Hearing

HB 2047

Requires sex offender to report within 10 days of legal change of name.

 $HB = 20\overline{48}$

Requires juvenile court to ensure that person who waives right to hearing on issue of reporting as sex offender, or who fails to appear at hearing, completes form documenting person's obligation to report.

HB 2049

Requires sex offender to report 21 days prior to intended travel outside United States.

Work Session

HB 2397

Removes provision under which certain actions of person in soliciting participation in contest or sweepstakes are unlawful practice only if solicitation occurs through use of United States mail.
