HB 2041

Adds parole and probation officers to definition of "police officer" for purposes of life insurance benefits for police officers and firefighters.

HB 2400

Extends deadline to appeal mental illness determination under certain circumstances.

HB 2631 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Corrections to establish pilot program to provide legal services that assist women who are incarcerated at Coffee Creek Correctional Facility to reenter and reintegrate into local communities, to reduce womens' vulnerability to domestic violence and to obtain employment, housing services and other benefits.

Work Session

HB 2042

Removes sunset date on temporary law and makes permanent law authorizing Oregon Youth Authority and county juvenile departments to disclose and provide copies of reports and other materials relating to child, ward, youth or youth offender's history and prognosis to Department of Corrections for specified purposes.

HB 2230

Limits amount of overtime nursing staff who work in correctional facility may be required to work.

HB 2515

Requires correctional facilities to provide tampons and sanitary napkins to incarcerated females at no cost.
