HB 2614

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/21/2019 AGENDA: Repeals driving privilege suspension and eliminates imposition of driving privilege restrictions for failure to pay fine.

HB 2472

Directs Health Licensing Office to register qualified applicant as sexual offense therapist intern.

#### Work Session

HB 2400

Extends deadline to appeal mental illness determination under certain circumstances.

HB 2041

Adds parole and probation officers to definition of "police officer" for purposes of life insurance benefits for police officers and firefighters.

HB 2045

Removes deadline by which State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision must perform risk assessment and classification on existing sex offender registrants.

HB 2631 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Corrections to establish pilot program to provide legal services that assist women who are incarcerated at Coffee Creek Correctional Facility to reenter and reintegrate into local communities, to reduce womens' vulnerability to domestic violence and to obtain employment, housing services and other benefits.
