HB 2866

Prohibits person from collecting, using, storing, analyzing, deriving inferences from, selling, leasing or otherwise transferring geolocation information or audiovisual data about resident individual without first obtaining express consent from resident individual and making certain disclosures to resident individual.

HB 2328 **

Modifies culpable mental state for crime of unauthorized use of a vehicle when person takes, operates, exercises control over or otherwise uses vehicle, boat or aircraft without consent of owner. ****Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means**
