- HB 2562 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for Title IX enforcement and compliance, sexual harassment prevention and gender discrimination prevention.
- HB 2657 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Justice to administer violence prevention funding program in consultation with Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force.
- HB 3077  
Modifies processes relating to reporting, investigating and appealing findings related to sexual harassment in schools.

- HB 3117  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/28/19 AGENDA: Extends period for filing restraining order under Family Abuse Prevention Act to two years from 180 days after date of abuse.

#### Work Session

- HB 2395  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/28/19 AGENDA: Requires person that manufactures, sells or offers to sell connected device to equip connected device with reasonable security features that protect information that connected device collects, contains, stores or transmits from access, destruction, modification, use or disclosure that consumer does not authorize.
- HB 3047  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/28/19 AGENDA: Modifies juvenile court dependency procedure to require any party issuing summons to bear financial responsibility for certain costs arising out of issuance of summons.
- HB 3146  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/28/19 AGENDA: Changes statutory references to "inmate" to "adult in custody."
