HB 2258

Directs Office of Governor to conduct study of family treatment courts and to report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services on or before September 15, 2020.

HB 2480

Creates exception to prohibition on recording communications for person who records conversation during or regarding commission of offense against person.

HB 3216

Creates offense of unlawfully summoning a police officer.

HB 3293

Directs State Court Administrator to study issues relating to civil proceedings and report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2020.

HB 2514

Provides that person retains privacy and possessory interest in contents of residential garbage receptacle until collection for disposal by sanitation company.
