Public Hearing

SB 810

Modifies definition of "vulnerable user of a public way" to include persons operating or riding on moped or motorcycle.

SB 975 A

Establishes procedures for persons with marijuana convictions to file motion requesting court to reduce offense classification if, since entry of judgment of conviction, offense classification has been reduced.

SB 420 A

Establishes procedures for persons with qualifying marijuana convictions to file motion requesting court to enter order setting aside conviction.

HB 3036

Permits judge, in determining whether person's alleged violation of restraining order violates condition of release or other probation condition, to take into consideration whether person was provoked into violating restraining order.

Work Session

SB 363 A

Permits Department of Justice to suspend support enforcement or hold back moneys received under support order from distribution if motion to modify support order may result in overpayment.

SB 364

Modernizes certain provisions regarding support order enforcement.
