Public Hearing

SB 726 A

Makes unlawful employment practice for employer to enter agreement that would prevent employee from disclosing or discussing conduct that constitutes unlawful discrimination, including sexual assault.

SB 318 A

Permits court to order equal parenting time when developing detailed parenting plan.

SB 356

Permits detailed parenting plan to include instructions regarding notification requirements for specified matters.

SB 385 A

Allows presiding judge of each judicial district to establish alternative dispute resolution conference procedure for custody and parenting time modifications and enforcement proceedings.

Work Session

SB 363 A

Permits Department of Justice to suspend support enforcement or hold back moneys received under support order from distribution if motion to modify support order may result in overpayment.

SB 364

Modernizes certain provisions regarding support order enforcement.
