#### **Public Hearing and Work Session**

SB 478 A

Prohibits campaign moneys and public moneys from being used to make payments in connection with nondisclosure agreement relating to workplace harassment.

SB 479 A

Requires public employers to adopt policies to prevent workplace harassment.

SB 980 A

Modifies procedures by which eligible moneys are collected from Department of Corrections inmates for payment of court-ordered financial obligations.

SB 1040 A

Makes owner, operator or lessee of quarry or mine located on property adjacent to Willamette River in Polk County and across river from City of Keizer liable for injuries resulting from bullets that stray outside boundaries of property if, after being notified that bullets have strayed, owner, operator or lessee fails to take reasonable measures to prevent additional bullets from straying.

#### **Work Session**

SB 11 A

Requires person who purchases residential real property after forclosure complaint has been filed and before end of redemption period to provide notice to seller regarding relinquishment of interests in property and rights to surplus funds.

SB 369 A

Modifies definition of "substantial completion" for purposes of statute of limitation for action arising out of construction, alteration or repair of improvement to real property.

SB 696

Increases amount of insurance policy that may be required by county governing body to approve permit for outdoor mass gathering.

SB 873 A

Allows defendant in eviction action to apply for order setting aside judgment.

SB 962 A

Directs certifying agencies to certify to United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, within specified time, victim helpfulness in detecting, investigating or prosecuting qualifying criminal activity.

SB 977 A

Repeals provisions relating to undertaking of justice of the peace.

SB 1008 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/16/19 AGENDA: Requires court to include in judgment document age of defendant at time of committing offense if defendant is sentenced to term of incarceration and physical custody of defendant is related to age of defendant at time of committing offense.
