#### Public Hearing

- HB 3044  
Requires business or individual carrying out application of soil treatment or pesticide by aircraft to record information regarding application conditions.
- HB 3080 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Creates Wildfire Suppression Fund and directs to fund 60 percent of revenue from additional privilege tax on harvesting forest products.
- HB 3084 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Prohibits tax on use of suitable material other than virgin material for daily cover at disposal site.
- HB 3168  
Authorizes operation of boats propelled by electric motors on named lakes and waters of this state under certain circumstances.

#### Work Session

- HB 2829 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.
- HB 2834 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in consultation with Department of Transportation, to develop Wildlife Corridor and Safe Road Crossing Action Plan for use by state agencies.
- HB 2841  
Allows State Department of Fish and Wildlife to refuse disclosure of information relevant to department ability to manage or protect described fish or wildlife species or individual members or populations of species.
