- HB 2952 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes new subaccount within State Forestry Department Account.
- HB 2953  
Requires State Forestry Department to report to committee of Legislative Assembly regarding environmental and employment impacts of Good Neighbor Authority Agreement projects funded in whole or in part by moneys made available to department for project purposes.

#### Work Session

- HB 2352  
Creates towed watersports program within State Marine Board.
- HB 2835 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes public right to recreational use of certain public use waterways.
- HB 2834 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in consultation with Department of Transportation, to develop Wildlife Corridor and Safe Road Crossing Action Plan for use by state agencies.
- HB 2574 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development to establish electronic information system to receive, consolidate and organize public record information concerning shellfish mariculture in Oregon.
- HB 3084 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Prohibits tax on use of suitable material other than virgin material for daily cover at disposal site.
- HB 3016 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Appropriates moneys to State Department of Fish and Wildlife for activities related to summer steelhead hatchery production for Santiam River.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3132  
Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to adopt by rule and administer program for authorizing voluntary projects for stream restoration and habitat improvement through construction of environmental restoration weirs.
