Public Hearing

HB 3436

Prohibits person from mailing or shipping cigars or inhalant delivery system without meeting certain requirements.

Work Session

HB 2387

Establishes refundable credit against personal income taxes for contributions to higher education savings network account or ABLE account.

SB 213 A

Updates connection date to federal Internal Revenue Code and other provisions of federal tax law.

SB 523 A

Authorizes Department of Revenue to make publicly available by posting online information about delinquent tax debtors.

HB 3135

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-20-2019 MEETING Requires Department of Revenue, for purpose of enforcing state and local transient lodging taxes, to purchase software that scrapes online data relating to transient lodging rentals.

HB 3136

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-20-2019 MEETING Requires Oregon Tourism Commission to transfer moneys to Department of Revenue for department's use in collecting local transient lodging taxes on local, rather than region level on behalf of units of local government.
