#### Public Hearing

HB 2900 A  
Extends sunset of exemption from property taxation for qualified machinery and equipment that is used in food processing.

#### Work Session

HB 2390  
Directs State Treasurer to study and make recommendations on provisions of state law relating to depositories of public funds.

HB 2429  
Provides that machinery and equipment used to compress and bale harvested straw, hay, grass or other plants for purpose of storage or shipment is tangible personal property exempt from ad valorem property taxation.

HB 2128  
Modifies definition of "tax expenditure" applicable to automatic tax expenditure sunset provisions by excluding provisions required by federal law.

HB 2787 A  
Specifies that certain taxes related to transacting wet marine and transportation insurance in this state apply to authorized insurers.

HB 2449 A  
**CARRIED OVER FROM THE 05-23-2019 MEETING** Increases rate of tax for emergency communications.

HB 2978  
**CARRIED OVER FROM THE 05-23-2019 MEETING** Creates tax credit for short line railroad rehabilitation projects.
