- HB 3034 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Legislative Assembly Paid Internships Program to provide stipends to interns performing services in offices of members of Legislative Assembly.
- HB 3046  
Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to include tribal boundaries on any legislative district maps department produces.
- HB 3173  
Specifies that when two or more county commissioners are elected for one county at same election and one is elected to fill vacancy, commissioner filling vacancy shall hold office for two years.
