HB 3409

Limits authority of school district to become member of voluntary organization that administers interscholastic activities or that facilitates scheduling and programming of interscholastic activities unless organization addresses specified behavior.

HB 3123

Provides that certain public bodies and intergovernmental entities may not issue bonds to finance pension liabilities without first obtaining assessment from independent registered municipal advisor of advisability of proposed bond issuance.
