Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2006
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-24-2019 AGENDA: Appropriates moneys to Housing and Community Services Department for grants to support services for families seeking or needing housing that have low or very low incomes.
- HB 3076
Requires nonprofit hospitals and hospital systems to establish financial assistance policies meeting specified criteria.
- HB 3202
Requires voter registration cards and electronic voter registration system to include option for person to identify race, ethnicity and preferred language of person.
- HCR 36
Recognizes and honors Chief Steve Bartol for his service to Milwaukie Police Department and State of Oregon.
- HJR 5
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-24-2019 AGENDA: Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to remove gender-specific references to public officials and replace with gender-neutral references to public officials.

Possible Work Session

- HB 3022
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-24-2019 AGENDA: Makes various changes to workers' compensation laws of this state.
- HB 3173
Specifies that when two or more county commissioners are elected for one county at same election and one is elected to fill vacancy, commissioner filling vacancy shall hold office for two years.
- HB 3274 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-24-2019 AGENDA: Requires eight percent of electricity sold in this state by each electric company that makes sales to 25,000 or more retail electricity consumers to be generated by small-scale renewable energy facilities or certain biomass facilities.
