Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2007 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule diesel engine emission standards for medium-duty trucks and heavy-duty trucks.
- HB 2876
Directs Department of Education to conduct study to determine adequacy of public education in state.
- HB 2886 A
Modifies law regarding requirement that public employer grant preference to veteran or disabled veteran in selection process for civil service position.
- HB 3076
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-29-2019 AGENDA: Requires nonprofit hospitals and hospital systems to establish financial assistance policies meeting specified criteria.
- HB 3432
Requires amendment of state building code to include special inspections to detect construction defects in exterior waterproofing system of common property of homeowners association, residential dwelling in planned community served by homeowners association or condominium.
- HCR 33
Urges Governor and state agencies to work with legislators, tribal governments, water stakeholders and others in cooperative process to create comprehensive state water vision.
- HCR 34
Expresses support for continued coordination and collaboration between Oregon and China.

HB 3274 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-29-2019 AGENDA: Requires eight percent of electricity sold in this state by each electric company that makes sales to 25,000 or more retail electricity consumers to be generated by small-scale renewable energy facilities or certain biomass facilities.

HB 3310

Prohibits school district, education service district and community college district elections from being conducted in manner that impairs ability of members of protected class to have equal opportunity to elect candidates of their choice as result of dilution or abridgment of rights of electors who are members of protected class.
