CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-01-2019 AGENDA: Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule diesel engine emission standards for medium-duty trucks and heavy-duty trucks.

HCR 33

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-01-2019 AGENDA: Urges Governor and state agencies to work with legislators, tribal governments, water stakeholders and others in cooperative process to create comprehensive state water vision.

HCR 34

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-01-2019 AGENDA: Expresses support for continued coordination and collaboration between Oregon and China.

HJR 10

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow juries to impose verdicts in criminal cases only by unanimous agreement.

SB 288
