Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2007 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule diesel engine emission standards for medium-duty trucks and heavy-duty trucks.
- HB 2882
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-08-2019 AGENDA: Allows cause of action against patent holder or licensed manufacturer for genetically engineered organism present on land without permission of owner or lawful occupant.
- HB 3076
Requires nonprofit hospitals and hospital systems to establish financial assistance policies meeting specified criteria.
- HB 3431
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-08-2019 AGENDA: Limits definition of "public building" or "property" to exclude convention or exposition centers, zoos, performing arts centers or other venues or attractions dedicated to tourism, travel, hospitality or entertainment for purposes of management by persons who are blind.
- HCR 33
Urges Governor and state agencies to work with legislators, tribal governments, water stakeholders and others in cooperative process to create comprehensive state water vision.
- HCR 34
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-08-2019 AGENDA: Expresses support for continued coordination and collaboration between Oregon and China.
- HJR 10
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow juries to impose verdicts in criminal cases only by unanimous agreement.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-08-2019 AGENDA: Prohibits sale, purchase or use of pesticide products containing chlorpyrifos.

HB 3123

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-08-2019 AGENDA: Provides that certain public bodies and intergovernmental entities may not issue bonds to finance pension liabilities without first obtaining assessment from independent registered municipal advisor of advisability of proposed bond issuance.

HB 3310

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-08-2019 AGENDA: Prohibits school district, education service district and community college district elections from being conducted in manner that impairs ability of members of protected class to have equal opportunity to elect candidates of their choice as result of dilution or abridgment of rights of electors who are members of protected class.
