#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 361 A  
Modifies prudent investor rule to allow trustee to consider settlor's or beneficiaries' personal values, including settlor's or beneficiaries' desire to engage in sustainable or socially responsible investment strategies aligning with settlor's or beneficiaries' social, environmental, governance or other values or beliefs, and beneficiaries' financial needs, when making investment decisions.
- SB 579  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6-05-2019 AGENDA: Creates exception under Death with Dignity Act to 15-day waiting period for patient with less than 15 days to live.
- SB 809 A  
Requires Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to prescribe by rule criteria to be considered in making fitness determination findings of abuse.
- SB 944 A  
Permits county clerk to decide whether to conduct hand count of ballots or risk-limiting audit following each primary, general or special election.
- SB 1002 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6-05-2019 AGENDA: Prohibits prosecuting attorney from conditioning defendant's plea offer on waiver of eligibility for transitional leave or certain sentence reductions.
- SCR 25  
Declares legislative support for survivors of sexual violence.
- SCR 33  
Declares that lung cancer is public health priority.

#### Possible Work Session

- SB 582 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6-05-2019 AGENDA: Authorizes Governor to enter into agreement with another state for purposes of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses and cross-jurisdictional delivery of marijuana items.

**June 6, 2019**

- SB 854 A  
Directs professional licensing boards, in certain circumstances, to accept individual taxpayer identification number or other federally-issued identification number in lieu of Social Security number on applications for issuance or renewal of authorization to practice occupation or profession.
- SB 855 A  
Directs professional licensing boards to study manner in which persons who are immigrants or refugees become authorized to practice occupation or profession.
