#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 113 B  
Provides that retail customer may bring individual action against vehicle dealer that fails to comply with certain requirements related to transfer of interest in vehicle.
- SB 905 A  
Establishes resident school district for child whose parent or guardian voluntarily placed child outside child's home with public or private agency and who is living in licensed, certified or approved substitute care program.
- SB 1025 A  
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to produce survey of bay clam populations in priority areas of Tillamook Bay.
- SCR 36  
In memoriam: George Kenneth "Ken" Austin Jr., 1931-2019.

#### Work Session

Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

- HB 2005  
Creates family and medical leave insurance program to provide employee who is eligible for coverage with portion of wages while employee is on family leave or medical leave.
- HCR 37  
Commends Mt. Hood Community College and Sandy River Watershed Council for collaborative work in improving fish habitat.
- SB 123 A  
Provides that employer is not in violation of pay equity requirements for paying different level of compensation to employee who is performing modified work in certain circumstances.

**June 13, 2019**

- SB 361 A  
Modifies prudent investor rule to allow trustee to consider settlor's or beneficiaries' personal values, including settlor's or beneficiaries' desire to engage in sustainable or socially responsible investment strategies aligning with settlor's or beneficiaries' social, environmental, governance or other values or beliefs, and beneficiaries' financial needs, when making investment decisions.
- SB 455 A  
Requires certain institutions of higher education to require contractors to employ apprentices and to establish and execute plan for outreach, recruitment and retention of women and minority individuals for certain work relating to improvements to real property.
- SB 935 A  
Creates modified landscape construction professional license.
- SB 944 A  
Permits county clerk to decide whether to conduct hand count of ballots or risk-limiting audit following each primary, general or special election.
- SCR 25  
Declares legislative support for survivors of sexual violence.
