HB 2450 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to develop training standards applicable to firefighting personnel in certain rural areas.

HB 2373

Allows State Forester to order use of wildfire suppression personnel, equipment and services on any federal lands within state borders. 2138 ** ** Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

HB 2138 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of volunteer emergency medical services in rural area.

HB 2620

Authorizes cities and rural fire protection districts to adopt plans to provide ambulance and emergency care services to city or rural fire protection district.

HB 2780

Provides that fire department may operate unmanned aircraft systems and acquire and disclose information through such operation for purposes of emergency incident response.
