Public Hearing

- HB 2450 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to develop training standards applicable to firefighting personnel in certain rural areas.
- HB 2373
Allows State Forester to order use of wildfire suppression personnel, equipment and services on any federal lands within state borders.
- HB 2138 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of volunteer emergency medical services in rural area.
- HB 2620
Authorizes cities and rural fire protection districts to adopt plans to provide ambulance and emergency care services to city or rural fire protection district.
- HB 2780
Provides that fire department may operate unmanned aircraft systems and acquire and disclose information through such operation for purposes of emergency incident response.
