Requires school districts to provide instruction and drills on how to prepare for and survive after natural disaster.
- HB 2206
Directs Office of Emergency Management to study and make recommendations regarding possible improvements to operations of office.
- HB 2205
Directs Office of Emergency Management to study and make recommendations regarding possible improvements to operations of office.
- HB 2208 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Oregon Business Development Department program to issue grants for improving seismic safety, stability and resiliency of qualifying unreinforced masonry and unreinforced concrete buildings.
- HB 2558 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Education to conduct study regarding impacts of major seismic event on children, including identifying methods for preparing schools and communities to meet needs of children following major seismic event.
