Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 59 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds for Connect Oregon.
- HB 2999
Directs Department of Transportation to issue up to two individual disability parking placards or decals upon request.

Work Session

- HB 2592
Directs Department of Transportation to study development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings and report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to transportation on or before September 15, 2020.
- HB 2770
Permits testing of highly automated vehicles on highways of this state under certain circumstances.
- HB 2881 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Replaces vehicle weight rating with designation as passenger vehicle as qualification for per-mile road usage charge program.
- HB 3213
Authorizes counties to establish safety corridors and directs counties to post signs in selected safety corridors.
- SB 558
Authorizes city to designate speed for highway under city's jurisdiction that is five miles per hour lower than statutory speed when highway is located in residence district and highway is not arterial highway.
- SB 666
Increases fee for Pacific Wonderland registration plates.
- SB 1021 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Transportation to add auxiliary lane on portion of Interstate 5 near City of Wilsonville and make seismic improvements to Boone Bridge.
- SB 1033
Provides that registered owner may request that registration card issued for vehicle include information that owner, or person operating vehicle, may be deaf or hard of hearing.
