Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 571 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue then to Tax Expenditures
Creates credit against income tax for taxpayers with not more than 100 employees that create 10 or more new jobs during tax year.
- SB 513 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to City of Mosier for construction of joint-use fire hall and community center.
- SB 258 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Business Development Department for distribution to certain entities for purposes of building entrepreneurial capacity in rural regions of this state, developing regional assets to support entrepreneurial growth and building network of statewide resources to leverage and accelerate access to resources regardless of location.
- SB 34
Amends industrial site readiness program to allow Oregon Business Development Department to enter into tax reimbursement arrangements for eligible site preparation costs with private owners.
- SB 219
Includes federally recognized Indian tribes located in this state among parties to whom Oregon Business Development Department may provide grants from Regional Infrastructure Fund.
- SB 68
Increases annual fee imposed on public utilities and telecommunications providers for purpose of defraying costs of Public Utility Commission.
- SB 69
Expands purposes of plan of assistance established by Public Utility Commission under Oregon Telephone Assistance Program to include supporting broadband internet access service.
