#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 417  
Establishes new exemptions from carrier of last resort obligation for telecommunications utilities, cooperative corporations and municipalities certified by Public Utility Commission to provide local exchange telecommunications service.
- SB 637  
Raises statutory threshold for requiring public utility to receive Public Utility Commission approval for disposition of certain property from \$100,000 to \$1 million.
- SB 505 \*\*  
Directs Oregon Broadband Advisory Council to study issues related to expansion of broadband capacity and access. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 393  
Authorizes translator districts to annex cities where cable television corporations operate or have ceased operations and city electors approve annexation.
- SB 394  
Permits translator districts to use specified technologies.
- SB 219  
Includes federally recognized Indian tribes located in this state among parties to whom Oregon Business Development Department may provide grants from Regional Infrastructure Fund.
