SB 39

Replaces exemption from laws regulating practice of engineering, land surveying and photogrammetric mapping with exemption from registration requirement.

SB 412

Requires Oregon Liquor Control Commission to establish advisory committee to assist commission in determining requirements for wine labeled as single-variety wine grown within American Viticultural Area located in Oregon.

SB 288

Expands where special district public bodies may hold public meetings to include locations within Indian country of federally recognized Oregon Indian tribe that is within Oregon.

SB 107

Provides exemption to utility vehicles providing natural gas services from offense of illegal stopping, standing or parking.
