Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

- SB 454
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/19/2019 AGENDA: Transfers administration of Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act, unclaimed estates and escheating funds from Department of State Lands to State Treasurer.
- SB 637
Raises statutory threshold for requiring public utility to receive Public Utility Commission approval for disposition of certain property from \$100,000 to \$1 million.
- SB 393
Authorizes translator districts to annex cities where cable television corporations operate or have ceased operations and city electors approve annexation.
- SB 394
Permits translator districts to use specified technologies.
- SB 258 **
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Business Development Department for distribution to certain entities for purposes of building entrepreneurial capacity in rural regions of this state, developing regional assets to support entrepreneurial growth and building network of statewide resources to leverage and accelerate access to resources regardless of location. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 654 **
Imposes public safety assessment on covered entities. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue

Note: The Work Session on SB 654 is being held for the sole purpose of referring the bill to the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue.

- SB 270
Exempts residential construction contractor meeting criteria from continuing education requirement.

- SB 443
Requires use of headlights at all times.
- SB 716
Requires retail seller or provider of essential goods and services to accept offer to pay by cash from retail buyer for purchase of goods or services.
- SB 372
Reduces period in which towers must provide notice to owners and lienholders of vehicle after towing vehicle.
