## Work Session

SB 72
Eliminates certain duties of Oregon Department of Administrative Services and other state agencies related to tracking and reporting of travel awards earned as part of official state business.

## Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 109
Specifies that certain documents prepared by or for internal use of financial institutions are not real estate appraisal activity requiring preparer of document to carry real estate appraiser certification, license or registration.
SB 418
Modifies requirement that start-up businesses that may be assisted by regional collaboration facilitated by Oregon Business Development Department have as purpose commercialization of university-based or university-assisted research and increasing number, and ensuring retention, of such businesses.
HB 2081
Modifies language regarding Oregon Heritage Commission's coordination of statewide activities recognizing events of historical significance.
HB 2088
Allows Department of Consumer and Business Services to restrict or suspend operations of endowment care cemetery for specified reasons.
