SB 614 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes prudent maximum amount of outstanding General Fund-supported debt as amount for which debt service due in biennium equals five percent of General Fund revenues estimated to be received in biennium.

SB 616 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides that State Treasurer may not recommend prudent maximum amount of lottery bonds that would cause combined existing and proposed lottery bond debt service to exceed 25 percent of unobligated net lottery proceeds.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2463

Permits pawnbroker to store large pledge items at single storage location off premises of business location at which pawnbroker makes pledge loan if pawnbroker and pledgor agree in writing that pawnbroker may do so.

HB 2749

Eliminates requirement that certificate issued to cosmetic practitioner include practitioner's address.

SB 803 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Secretary of State to establish rules authorizing licensed use of state seal on goods, wares and merchandise.

SB 320

Abolishes annual one-hour change in time from standard time to daylight saving time and maintains Oregon on daylight saving time.
