Work Session

- SB 109
Specifies that certain documents prepared by or for internal use of financial institutions are not real estate appraisal activity requiring preparer of document to carry real estate appraiser certification, license or registration.
- SB 251
Updates various statutes in Insurance Code to reflect changes in National Association of Insurance Commissioners model provisions related to reducing reserve requirements for domestic ceding insurers that cede insurance to reinsurers and to regulating insurance adjusters and insurance consultants.
- SB 34
Amends industrial site readiness program to allow Oregon Business Development Department to enter into tax reimbursement arrangements for eligible site preparation costs with private owners.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 419
Applies retroactive to January 1, 2009, Oregon Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association's \$300,000 liability limit for long term care insurance.
- SB 854
Directs professional licensing boards, in certain circumstances, to accept individual taxpayer identification number or other federally-issued identification number in lieu of Social Security number on applications for issuance or renewal of authorization to practice occupation or profession.
- SB 855
Directs professional licensing boards to develop pathways to licensure, certification or other authorization to practice occupation or profession for specified persons.
- SB 856 **
Establishes Oregon Office of New Americans in Governor's office. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
