Work Session

- SB 34
Amends industrial site readiness program to allow Oregon Business Development Department to enter into tax reimbursement arrangements for eligible site preparation costs with private owners.
- SB 803 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Secretary of State to establish rules authorizing licensed use of state seal on goods, wares and merchandise.

Public Hearing

- SB 346
Declares policy of state to use zero-based budgeting in developing biennial budget plan.
- SB 611 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Declares policy of state to use zero-based budgeting in developing biennial budget plan.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 933
Provides that form or document issued by public body asking person to identify person's race or ethnicity must allow person to select multiple races or ethnicities and include certain categories of race or ethnicity.
- SB 1012
Clarifies that, to qualify for exemption from land use compatibility statement, applicant for marijuana production license is not required to demonstrate continuous registration of marijuana grow site prior to date of application for licensure.
