Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2275
Adds certain individuals to list of persons exempt from real estate licensing law.
- HB 2312 A
Requires seller of property to disclose whether seller has ever purchased flood insurance.
- HB 2769 A
Permits contracting agency, in conducting procurement for architectural, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation planning and land surveying services, to consider pricing policies, proposals and other pricing information as part of screening and selection of consultants in specified circumstances.
- HB 2973
Increases terms of office of advocacy commission members, from three to four years.
- HB 3143 A
Revises definitions regarding activities and oral representations constituting practice of engineering, professional engineering or land surveying.
