#### Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2486  
Allows Real Estate Agency to electronically facilitate condominium reporting process.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2454 A  
Allows out-of-state applicant seeking occupational license in Oregon more time to meet Oregon standards if applicant is already licensed in another state and is seeking to work in Eastern Oregon Border Economic Development Region.

HB 3030 A  
Allows professional licensing board to issue nonrenewable temporary authorization to spouse of member of Armed Forces of United States stationed in Oregon and who holds eligible out-of-state authorization to provide occupational or professional service.

HB 3065 A  
Directs Public Utility Commission to establish public process for investigating continuing relevance of telecommunications carrier of last resort obligations.

HB 2054 A  
Makes program changes to Oregon Innovation Council statutes.

HB 2415 A  
Requires that retainage be placed in interest-bearing account if contract price exceeds \$500,000.
