Requires school district to adopt policy on student suicide prevention.
- SB 485
Directs Oregon Health Authority to collaborate with certain schools and facilities when developing plan for communication following suspected suicide.
- SB 180 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Education to award grants to school districts to support safe schools by funding programs related to bullying prevention and youth empowerment.
- SB 489 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Encourages school districts to collaborate and enter into agreements with law enforcement and providers of social media websites and applications for purpose of responding to acts of cyberbullying.
