Public Hearing

- SB 12
Establishes inclusive schools pilot program.
- SB 14
Directs Department of Education to develop and implement statewide education plan for early childhood through post-secondary education students who are American Indians or Alaskan Natives and who have experienced disproportionate educational results.
- SB 293 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Indian Health Scholarship Program to provide free tuition and fees for qualifying Indian health profession students in exchange for student commitment to work at tribal service site after graduation.
- SB 312 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires public universities and community colleges to charge resident tuition to Native Americans and Alaska Natives who graduated from Oregon high schools.
- SB 496
Requires school districts to ensure that all students of school district have equal access to educational facilities.
