SB 154

Directs Department of Education to conduct study to determine which statewide summative test to administer to students in grade 11.

SB 428

Directs Secretary of State to conduct audit of use of statewide summative assessment in public schools in this state. SB 433

Modifies process for revising form or notice sent to parents or adult students regarding statewide standardized assessments.

SB 456

Prohibits State Board of Education, school district or public charter school from requiring student to pass test to demonstrate proficiency in Essential Learning Skills in order to receive diploma.
