Work Session

SB 16

Specifies types of licensed health care practitioners authorized to perform assessments or examinations for purposes of determining special education services eligibility.

SB 160

Requires public institutions of higher education to provide credit to each student who receives grade of four or higher on International Baccalaureate (IB) exam.

SB 730

Integrates foundational curricula and unified statewide transfer agreements into Transfer Student Bill of Rights and Responsibilities.

- SB 739 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success then to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to University of Oregon for program that strives to improve high school graduation rates through collaborative partnerships between university faculty and high school teachers.
- **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success then to Ways and Means SB 802 ** Allows military child to be considered resident of school district for purposes of enrollment and class placement based
 - on official military order for transfer of parent of child.
 - SB 690 A
 - Repeals sunset provision for Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
 - SB 859 **
 - Exempts graduate students at public universities who qualify for tuition equity from having to pay nonresident tuition. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means SB 958 **

Establishes Dreamers Access Program to award student loans to eligible students with demonstrated financial need.
