- SB 42 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Eliminates sunset for funding dedicated to State Department of Fish and Wildlife fish restoration and enhancement program.
- SB 259 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Maritime Sector Workforce Development.
- SB 260
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish program for strategic investments in initiatives related to ocean acidification and hypoxia.
- SB 753 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes executive director of Oregon Ocean Science Trust to enter into agreement with private, nonprofit organization under which organization shall solicit gifts, grants and donations in support of work of trust.
