SB 508

Specifies that electricity generated by hydroelectric facility or other equipment that generates electricity through use of hydroelectric energy may be used to comply with renewable portfolio standard.

SB 517

Requires manufacturer, distributor or importer of beverage sold in this state to ensure that beverage containers are collected from small dealer no later than 30 days after dealer redeems beverage containers.

SB 914

Requires certain distributors and importers to register with distributor cooperatives and provide certain information to distributor cooperatives.

HB 2086 A

Revises definitions and harmonizes language for purposes of program supporting working land conservation.
