SB 792

Removes exemption of auto dismantlers holding dismantler certificate from definition of "disposal site" for purposes of solid waste management regulation by Department of Environmental Quality.

SB 451

Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.

SB 99

Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to high hazard train routes in this state.

SB 695

Eliminates cap on amount of debt that ports may incur by promissory note.
