Public Hearing

- SB 927 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allows local governments to develop historic resource program to designate resources for protection.
- SB 929 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures then to Ways and Means
Creates tax credit for certified historic property project contributions.
- SB 853 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits sale, purchase or use of pesticide chlorpyrifos.

Work Session

- SB 884 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes qualified institutions to receive loans from Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund to finance projects to repair or replace failing on-site septic systems or to replace failing on-site septic systems with connections to available sewer.
