#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 92  
Authorizes city to provide for as much as 20-year ramp-up to full taxation rate for property in annexed territory.
- SB 302  
Allows person taking certain nuisance game mammals to retain game meat if meat is offered to charitable organizations and refused.
- SB 590  
Conditionally limits space considered to be occupied by dealer for purposes of obligation to redeem beverage containers.
- SB 885  
Extends and modifies program limiting canola production in Willamette Valley Protected District.
- SB 926  
Prohibits aerial application of pesticide on certain lands owned by state.
- SB 931  
Establishes requirements for sending notification to State Forestry Department by operator, timber owner or landowner proposing forest operation involving aerial application of pesticide to nonfederal forestland.
- SB 946  
Makes process for transfer of water use applicable to qualifying right to store water.

#### Work Session

- SB 42 A\*\*  
Eliminates sunset for funding dedicated to State Department of Fish and Wildlife fish restoration and enhancement program. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 88  
Allows counties to authorize construction of accessory dwelling units on lands zoned for rural residential use.
- SB 93  
Provides that beverage container redemption centers are not recycling depots for purposes of certain recycling laws.

- SB 448 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Office of Outdoor Recreation to study and make recommendations on development of Oregon Outdoors Pass.
- SB 451  
Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.
