Work Session

- SB 93
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Provides that beverage container redemption centers are not recycling depots for purposes of certain recycling laws.
- SB 247
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Requires persons responsible for operation of beverage container redemption centers to annually register with Oregon Liquor Control Commission and pay registration fee.
- SB 276
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Establishes product stewardship program for mattresses.
- SB 448 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Directs Office of Outdoor Recreation to study and make recommendations on development of Oregon Outdoors Pass. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 451
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.
- SB 876 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Requires Department of Environmental Quality or State Department of Agriculture approval as prerequisite to construction, installation, operation or maintenance of large confined animal feeding operation or large concentrated animal feeding operation. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 883
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Changes definition of "enforcing agency" from city or county dog licensing agency or other designated agency to State Veterinarian for purposes of regulating animal rescue entities.
- SB 926
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Prohibits aerial application of pesticide on certain lands owned by state.

- SB 927 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Allows local governments to develop historic resource program to designate resources for protection.
- SB 929 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures then to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Creates tax credit for certified historic property project contributions.
- SB 931
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Establishes requirements for sending notification to State Forestry Department by operator, timber owner or landowner proposing forest operation involving aerial application of pesticide to nonfederal forestland.
- SB 946
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Makes process for transfer of water use applicable to qualifying right to store water.
- SB 1019
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Amends standards regulating egg production and sale of eggs and egg products.
- SB 1025
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2019 MEETING: Limits actions of persons that take claims for commercial purposes.

- SB 772 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Forest Health Enhancement to design program for carrying out certain forest-related activities.
- SB 928
Establishes Oregon Climate Authority.
- SB 1031 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Environmental Quality for deposit in Residential Solid Fuel Heating Air Quality Improvement Fund to fund grants that support community efforts to improve economic development and public health by reducing emissions from solid fuel burning devices that burn wood.

Work Session

- SB 46
Clarifies applicability of surface mining exclusion certificate to multiple sites and on federal and state lands.
- SB 301
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to consider elk overpopulation when implementing the Oregon Landowner Damage Program.
- SB 522
Prohibits person from intentionally returning for refund value during one day 25 or more individual beverage containers that person knows or has good reason to know were not sold in this state.
- SB 853 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits sale, purchase or use of pesticide chlorpyrifos.
