#### **Public Hearing**

HB 2109

Requires that, in election proposing annexation, votes from city and territory to be annexed be counted separately to determine separate majorities if territory to be annexed includes 100 acres or more.

HB 2351 A

Authorizes State Marine Board to adopt special regulations to protect shoreline in Willamette River Greenway.

HB 2577 A

Requires minimum three-year delay of effective date for annexation of property that is zoned to allow residential use as permitted use in zone and is in residential use when annexation is initiated.

HB 3114 A

Makes changes to requirements for recycling certain electronic devices.

HB 3384 A

Limits reasons counties may deny expansion of certain schools on land zoned for exclusive farm use.

#### **Work Session**

HB 2060 A

Authorizes State Department of Agriculture to order condemnation or closure of food establishment if department authorization required for operation of food establishment has not been obtained or has lapsed.

HB 2077

Requires boat livery registration for operators of boat liveries.

HB 2078 A

Modifies laws related to boating safety education.

HB 2652 A

Requires outfitters and guides to rent, sell or otherwise make available helmets to all passengers on any section of waters rated as class III or higher on commonly accepted scale of river difficulty.
