Public Hearing

- HB 2225 A
Defines "center of the subject tract" for siting certain permissible forest dwellings.
- HB 2835 A
Requires state agencies to post notice on agency website before restricting or closing site on state public lands where public may access lands for recreational use of floatable natural waterway.
- HB 2844 A
Allows facilities for processing farm products under 2,500 square feet on lands zoned for exclusive farm use without regard to siting standards.
- HB 2914 A
Removes requirement that certain Metro lands be zoned for employment land of state significance.
- HB 3168
Authorizes operation of boats propelled by electric motors on named lakes and waters of this state under certain circumstances.

Work Session

- HB 2084
Extends sunset date for Water Resources Department grant program for place-based integrated water resources strategies.
- HB 2222 A
Requires State Forestry Department to annually report to Legislative Assembly or interim committee regarding implementation and enforcement of property notifications and certifications required under Oregon Forestland-Urban Interface Fire Protection Act.
- HB 2250 A
Requires Department of Environmental Quality and Oregon Health Authority to regularly assess final changes to federal environment laws to determine whether changes are significantly less protective of public health, environment or natural resources than standards and requirements contained in those federal environmental laws, as in effect on January 19, 2017.
